

ProMark3 Operating System Ver. 2.13 Release Notes

1. Resolved Problems

1.1. Modify GPS Data Server startup

When no battery was present inside the PM3, and the internal capacitor was fully discharged, the processor could lose its real-time clock. When the GPS Data Server queried the GPS receiver for the backup time at startup, the response was blocked until the GPS firmware responded with a ZDA message, which was not forthcoming.

This communication deadlock (a) prevented the Magellan System Info utility from getting the GPS firmware version number (returning a "GPS not available" message), and (b) prevented the Mobile Mapping data logging application from working properly.

The blocking situation has been fixed with a time-out mechanism.

1.2 Modify Bluetooth Manager

The Bluetooth Manager was modified to support 3G GPRS cell phones
